

## RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES POLICIES

- The MMR is used for worship on Thur, Saturday and Sunday. Improvements to the room to enhance the worship experience limit some recreational activities. The MMR is a true **Multi-Ministry** Room and is not a gym. The facility construction is not designed to handle any aggressive type recreation activities. As such, the following activities will not be approved in our Multi-Ministry room. These activities include but are not limited to: soccer, football, kickball, baseball, softball, hockey, lacrosse, field hockey and non inflatable ball sports. We encourage you to experience our worship times to fully understand the importance of this room as a worship center and multi ministry facility. The room is supplied with Volleyball and Basketball nets for approved recreational activities. Requests for activities other than those listed above will be referred to the facilities team for review.
- All sports/recreational activities are for practice only. **NO COMPETITION/LEAGUE GAMES ARE PERMITTED.**
- Avoid contact with the curtains and the wall (both carpeted/ padded walls and drywall) – EX. Do not use cones or chairs as a net with the wall being the net. Nets are part of the equipment that should be used when needed.
- Shoes shall be non- marking shoes – no cleats
- Organization requesting use of the room will be responsible for ensuring all participants are using appropriate safety gear for their activity.
- No storage of equipment is permitted – please take home all equipment at the end of each practice.
- Do not enter the outside doors located in the MMR. These are exit doors only. Do not prop these doors open during any rain or inclement weather.
- When exiting room be certain the outside doors are completely latched tight.
- Turn off all lights when leaving – if CUMC Ambassador is not available
- Lock door when leaving – if CUMC Ambassador is not available
- Return key (if applicable)after last session
- Leave the room the way you found it
- We encourage you to learn more about CUMC and developing a deeper relationship with Christ. Please feel free to use our sanctuary for prayer or devotions. Please respect the house of worship and do not use the remainder of the building as a recreational room.
- We encourage you to take literature that will help you to develop the deeper relationship with Christ.
- If a CUMC Ambassador is available to assist you with keys and access to the MMR, they will also advise if the policies are not being followed. CUMC reserves the right to withdraw approval if the policies are not followed.
- For all reservations except ministries and members of CUMC, a responsible party for the activity must meet with the CUMC ambassador, or MMR coordinator prior to approval. Review of polices will be conducted at that time and the responsible party will be required to sign the policy acceptance form including contact information. The insurance policy rider if applicable will be due at that time. Approval or activity will not be issued until these forms are complete.
