- **AFFIRMING OUR FAITH** —Based on Romans 10:8b-13

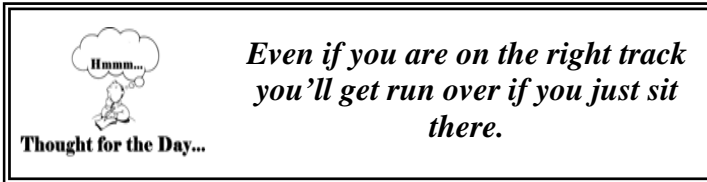

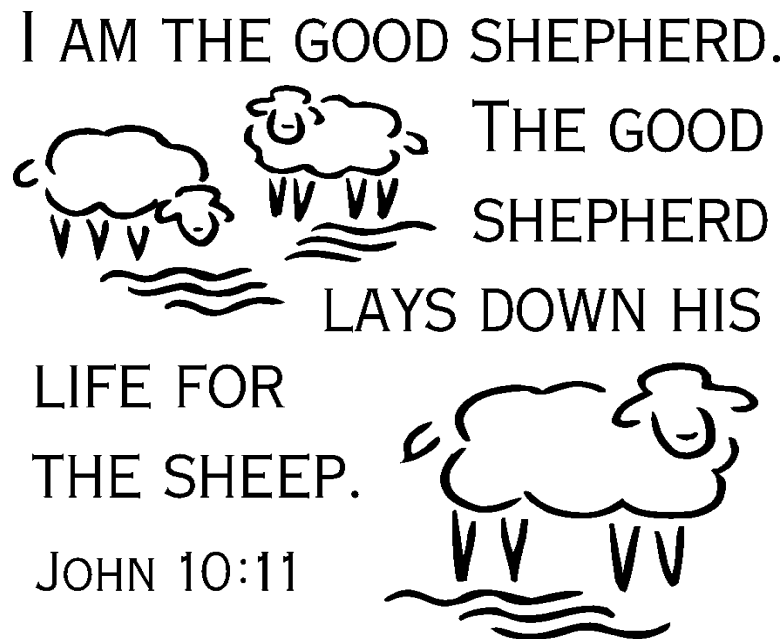
