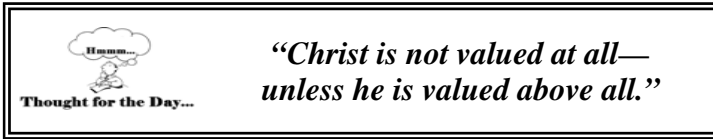
CALL TO WORSHIP -

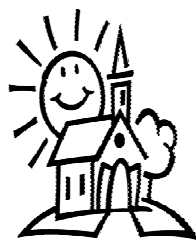

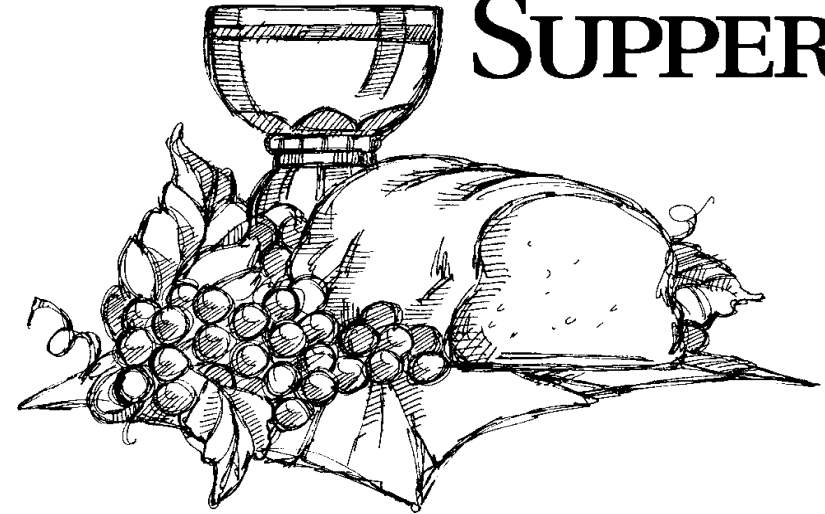
