PEOPLE: *Praise the Lord!*

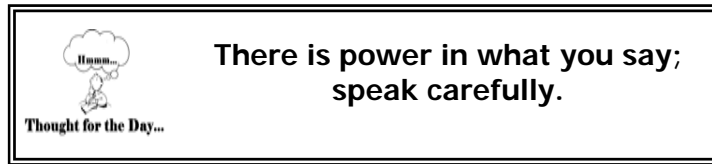

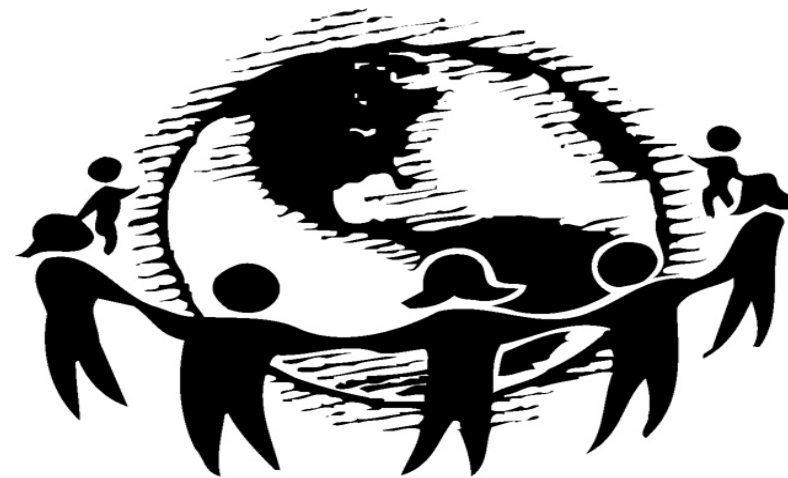
