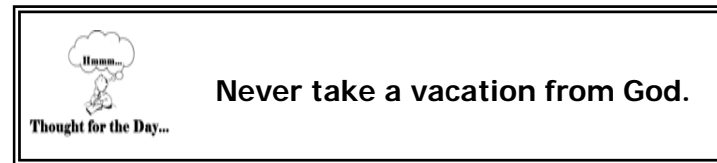
### ● AFFIRMING OUR FAITH

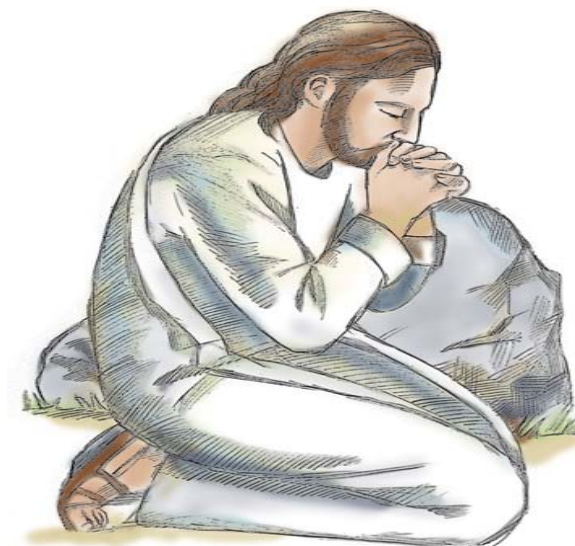
