ALL: *He guides us and protects us. We look to the Good Shepherd to save us from evil and lead us to abundant life.*

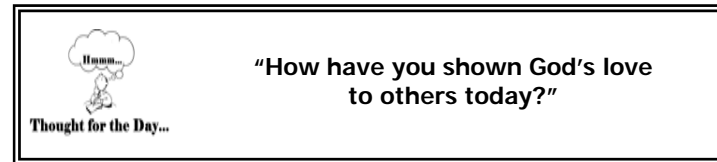

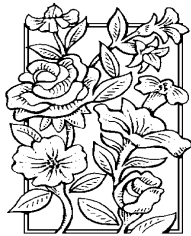
