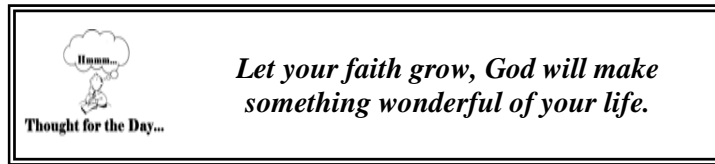
• PRAYING TOGETHER
